The following points clarify what is expected of the scholarship holder..

1. The scholarship holder is responsible for informing his/her academic supervisor about the MFS and what is expected of him/her, and for agreeing on the thesis format and any changes that are made.
2. The scholarship holder is responsible for contacting his/her supervisor in the field and informing him/her about what is expected of him/her.

3. The scholarship holder is responsible for all practical preparations such as booking travel, arranging necessary vaccinations, arranging accommodation, visas and checking his/her insurance coverage during his/her field study..
4. The scholarship holder is responsible for staying informed about the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' travel recommendations before and during his/her stay.
5. Upon arrival in the country of residence, the scholarship holder should contact the embassy/consulate and provide his/her address and inform about the purpose of the stay.
6. The scholarship holder is responsible for notifying the MFS administrator at the Swedish Defence University if the student does not go on his/her field study for any reason or if the field study is interrupted or shortened.
7. The scholarship holder is responsible for submitting used travel documents upon their return home, e.g. boarding card to the MFS coordinator at the Swedish Defence University.
8. The scholarship holder is responsible for feeding back the results of the study to the country of residence, including organizations or contact persons involved or helpful to the study.
9. The scholarship holder is responsible for sending the examined essay to the MFS coordinator at the Swedish Defence University.
10. After returning home, the scholarship holder must complete and submit a participant report.
11. Present the project to other students on your course.
12. Participate in the knowledge dissemination process and in events organized by the International Office or your department.
